We are having a Quilt Show Challenge for the quilt show next year. Come in and pick up the packet. The cost is \$10 and \$7 of that will go towards prizes. There will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place awards. People attending the quilt show will determine the awards. **NOTE:** The project does not need to be in until the 1st of July 2007. You can make most anything that you want as long as you use most of the challenge fabric.

CLASSES

Class Notes: To take quilting classes there is a certain proficiency required. At the beginning of the "Beginning" classes we will teach rotary cutting techniques. All students need to be comfortable with their sewing machine. For the "Intermediate" and "Advanced" classes you need to have been quilting for awhile and be very comfortable with a rotary cutter and using a 1/4" seam

Tools needed for all classes are a sewing machine in good working order, rotary cutter, pins, seam ripper, cutting mat and ruler. There may be other specific items needed for a particular class. These will be listed on a supply list.

Pre-registration is required and all classes need to be paid for at registration, if there is a fee. This will ensure that there is space available for you. The minimum class size is 3 and the maximum is 6, unless the instructor agrees to more students.

Barbara and LaDonna will be teaching classes/demos until Patty comes back in the Spring. Most of them will be easy and quick classes or demos. These will be free. There will not be a 15% discount on fabric and patterns for these. Some of them will have patterns supplied. The fabric and patterns need to be purchased here. There will be a charge for the intermediate and advanced classes.

Unless we have a scheduled class, every Saturday is a "Free Sew Saturday".

Demonstration Classes:

Easy Striped Table Runner – Beginner – Free – Pattern supplied. There has been quite a bit of interest in this one. If you haven't seen it, come into the store. Although this is a demo class, you are free to bring your machine and supplies in and work on it after the demo. If you plan on doing this, come in and sign up so we will know how much space we need. Barbara will be doing the demos.

Reversible Table Runner Too – Friday, the 25th at 9:00 am – Beginner/Advanced Beginner – Class fee: \$7.50 – Each student will need their sewing equipment, a pattern and fabric. We have a sample if you have not seen this one. Come in and sign up and get your pattern. Barbara will be teaching this class.

Zippered Up Tote – Wednesday, the 30th at 9:30 am. – Advanced Beginner – Class Fee: \$10.00. This a great tote with 4 zippers. This requires pre-quilted fabric. If you are planning on making it out of regular fabric, it will need to be quilted before the class. When you register you will need to buy the pattern so that you will know what is required to make the project. LaDonna will be teaching this class.
