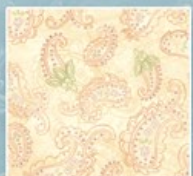

PERFECTLY PAISLEY

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 1 - 9" x 23 1/2" squares (center design evenly)

Fabric B - Fussy cut 4 squares 8 1/4" x 8 1/4", centering identical images, cut in half  diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles (4 identical sets)

cut Blue 3" strips lengthwise (to total approximately 45"). *See step 3 for cutting half trapezoids.

Fabric C - cut 1 - 5" strip, subcut 9 - 3 1/2" x 5" rectangles
Border - cut 2 - 2" x 28" (Sides)

cut 2 - 4 3/4" x 36 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

Fabric D - cut 3 - 5" strips

Fabric E - cut 2 - 3" strips

Fabric F - cut 2 - 4" strips

Fabric G - cut 3 - 2" strips

Fabric H - cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips

Borders - cut 6 - 2" strips, subcut 4 - 2" x 25" and 2 - 2" x 33 1/2"

Fabric I - cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips

**cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/4" x 23 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/4" x 10 1/2"

cut 5 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 4 - 1 1/4" x 25" and


4 - 1 1/4" x 7 1/2"

cut 1 - 1 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"

BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric J - cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 18 - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

Fabric K - cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips

Fabric L - cut 2 - 4 3/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 8 triangles 

Fabric M - cut 3 - 3" strips, subcut 18 - 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

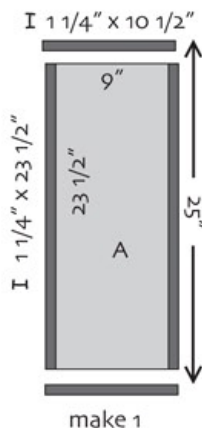
Fabric N - cut 2 - 5 1/2" strips, subcut 18 - 4" x 5 1/2" rectangles

Fabric O - cut 1 - 5" strip, subcut 9 - 3 1/2" x 5" rectangles

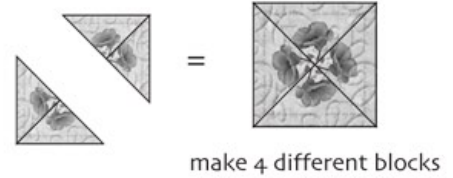
2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **I** 1 1/4" borders around **A** center panel, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram.

** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **I** borders slightly larger, sew around **A**, then trim block to measure 10 1/2" x 25" .)

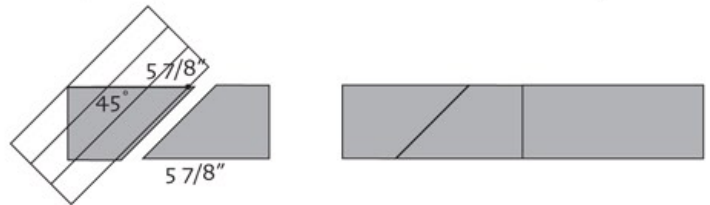


2. Sew 4 identical **B** triangles together for 4 different kaleidoscope type blocks - 7" finished (7 1/2" unf.)



3. Cut **B** half trapezoids first by making a clean square cut on the left side of 3" strip. Next, measure 5 7/8" along the top row edge of the strip. Place the 45° angle of the ruler over the raw edge, even with the 5 7/8" mark and cut angle. Next, measure 5 7/8" along the bottom row edge from the tip of the previous cut.

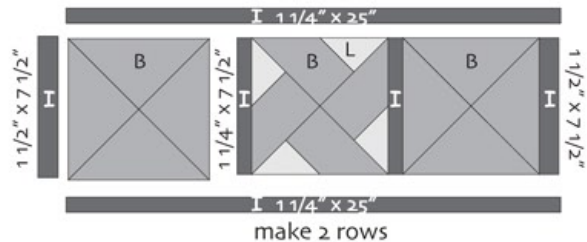
Make a straight cut. Repeat for 8 half trapezoids. Strips may be stacked but do not cut folded strips.



Make 2 - 7" finished (7 1/2" unf.) Windmill blocks. Sew **L** triangles to **B** half trapezoids, then sew large triangles together according to the diagram for 2 blocks.



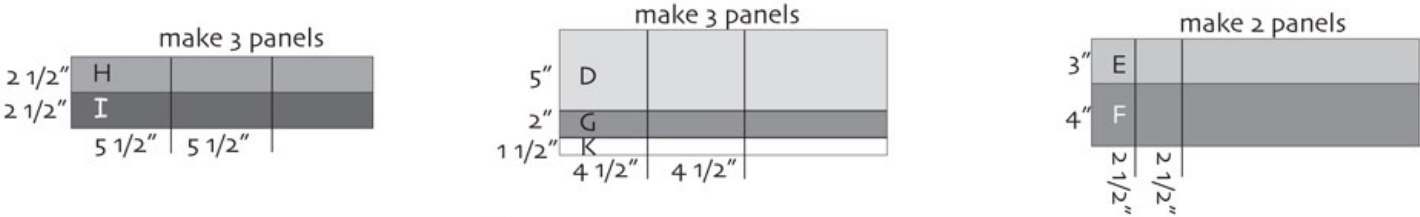
4. Sew **B** blocks (step 2) and Windmill blocks alternating **Fabric I** 7 1/2" sashing strips (1 1/2" x 7 1/2" on the ends and 1 1/4" x 7 1/2" in the middle). Then sew **I** 1 1/4" x 25" according to the diagram.



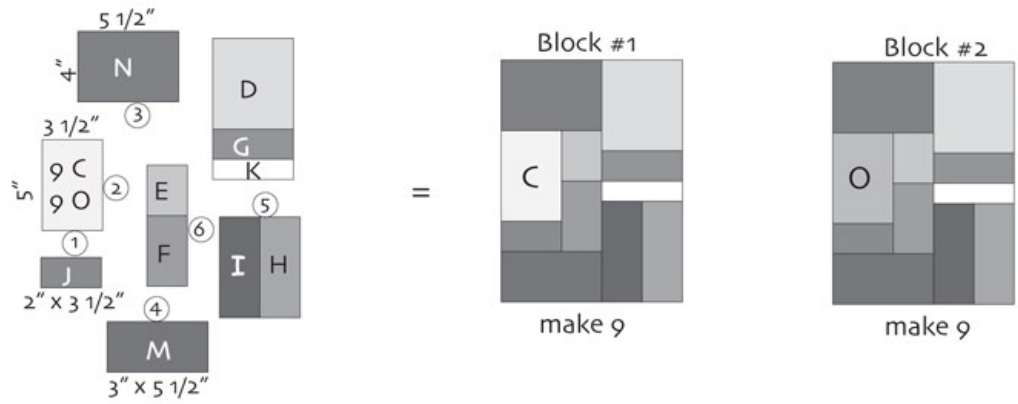
5. Sew quilt center together by rows of blocks, center panel **A** and four **H** 2" x 25" according to the diagram on the last page. Then sew **H** 2" x 33 1/2" borders to the top and bottom.

6. Sew **C** 2" x 28" to both quilt center **SIDES**. Then sew **C** 4 3/4" x 36 1/2" to the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** according to the diagram.

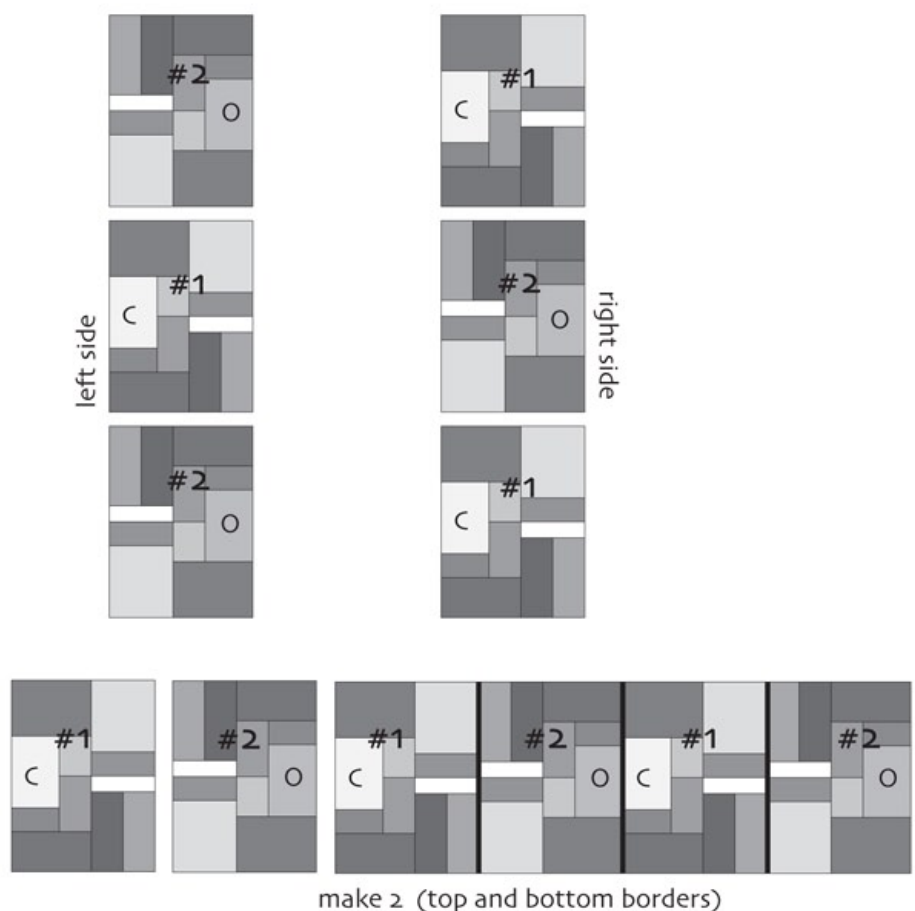
7. Make 18 - 9" x 12" finished (9 1/2" x 12 1/2") Pieced blocks for the outer border. First, sew **I** and **H** 2 1/2" strips, side by side (make 3 strip panels), subcut 18 - 5 1/2" segments. Next, sew **D** 5", **G** 2" and **K** 1 1/2" strips, side by side (make 3 strip panels), subcut 18 - 4 1/2" segments. Then, sew **E** 3" and **F** 4" strips, side by side (make 2 strip panels), subcut 18 - 2 1/2" segments.

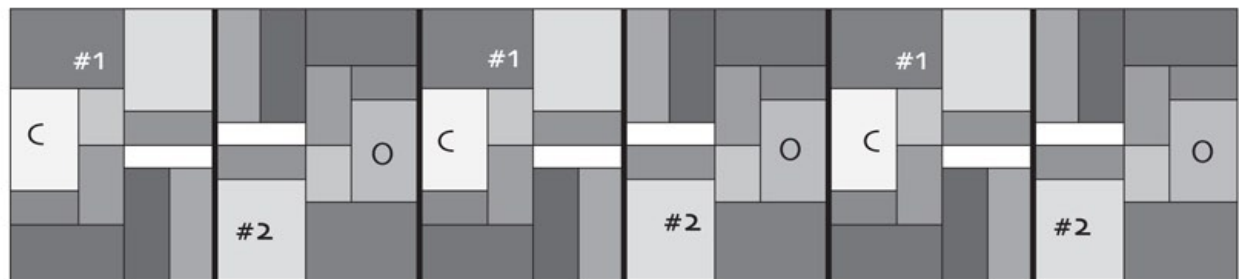
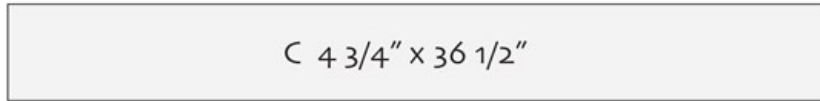
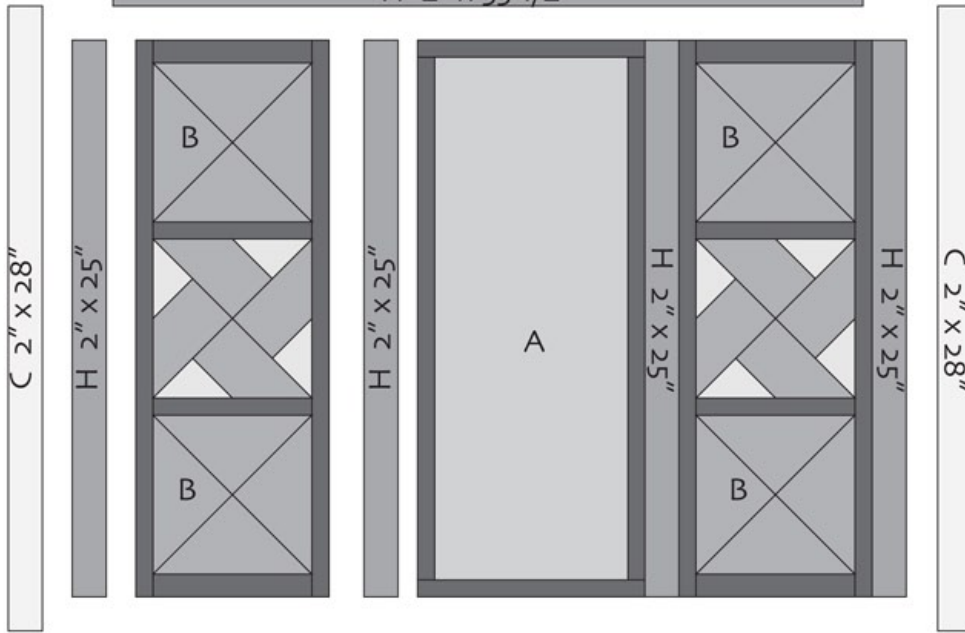
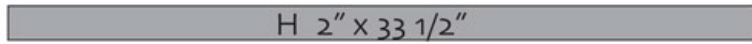
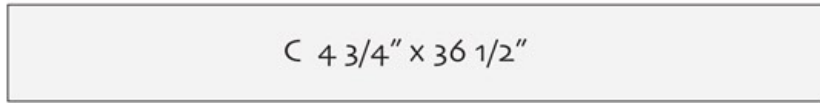
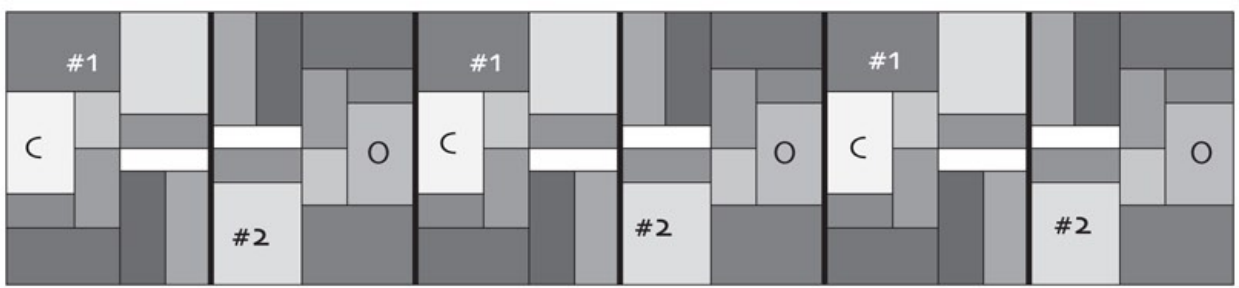


Then, sew segments and rectangles together by rows according to the numbered diagram. (Circled numbers show sewing order.)



8. Sew two #2 and one #1 blocks together for the left side. Sew two #1 and one #2 blocks together for the right side. Sew three #1 and two #1 blocks together for the TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram. Sew SIDE borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders. (Pay attention to the orientation of block #2 when sewing rows.)





9. The quilt measures approximately 55" x 61". Make backing (**Fabric L**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!
