# Picked Fresh

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated. Make both sides of the reversible Table Topper (approximately 56" x 56" each) then follow the finishing instructions on page 3.

## SIDE 1 Instructions

### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - \*\*cut 4 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut identical borders lengthwise - cut 4 - 10 1/2" x LOF (includes borders for Side 2)

**Fabric C** - cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 4 1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - cut 1 - 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" center square

**Fabric F** - cut 1 - 9 1/4" strip, then subcut: 2 - 9 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 8 triangles ☒, and cut 2 - 8 7/8" x 8 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 large triangles ☐

cut 1 - 4 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles ☐

**Fabric G** - cut 1 - 9 1/4" strip, then subcut 3 - 9 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 12 triangles ☒

cut 2 - 8 7/8" x 8 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 large triangles ☐

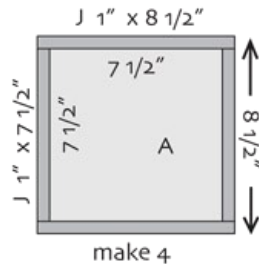
**BINDING** - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

**Fabric J** - \*\*cut 4 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 7 1/2" (Sides) and 8 - 1" x 8 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

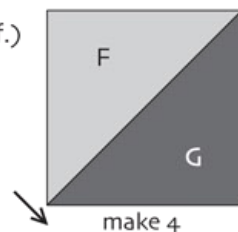
Borders - cut 12 - 1 1/2" strips (4 - Inner, 8 - Outer borders)

### 2. Piecing Order:

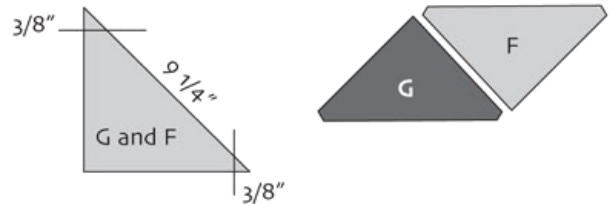
- Sew **J** 1" borders around 4 **A** 7 1/2" squares, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. \*\* (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **J** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** blocks, then trim all **A** blocks to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" .)



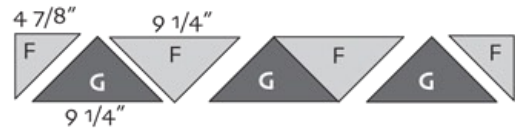
- Make 4 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) Half Square Triangle units by sewing **G** and **F** 8 7/8" triangles together. Press toward **G**.



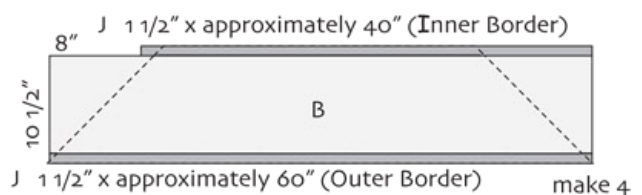
**TIP** for perfect piecing: Pre-nub **G** and **F** 9 1/4" triangles by cutting 3/8" off tip of triangles. Pre-nubbing takes the guesswork out of placement when sewing triangles and square corners. Simply match square corners after pre-nubbing tips.



- Sew (2) **F** and (3) **G** 9 1/4" triangles together for 4 borders. Next, sew **F** 4 7/8" triangles to both ends of all borders. Then sew **C** 4 1/2" squares to both ends for two **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagrams.

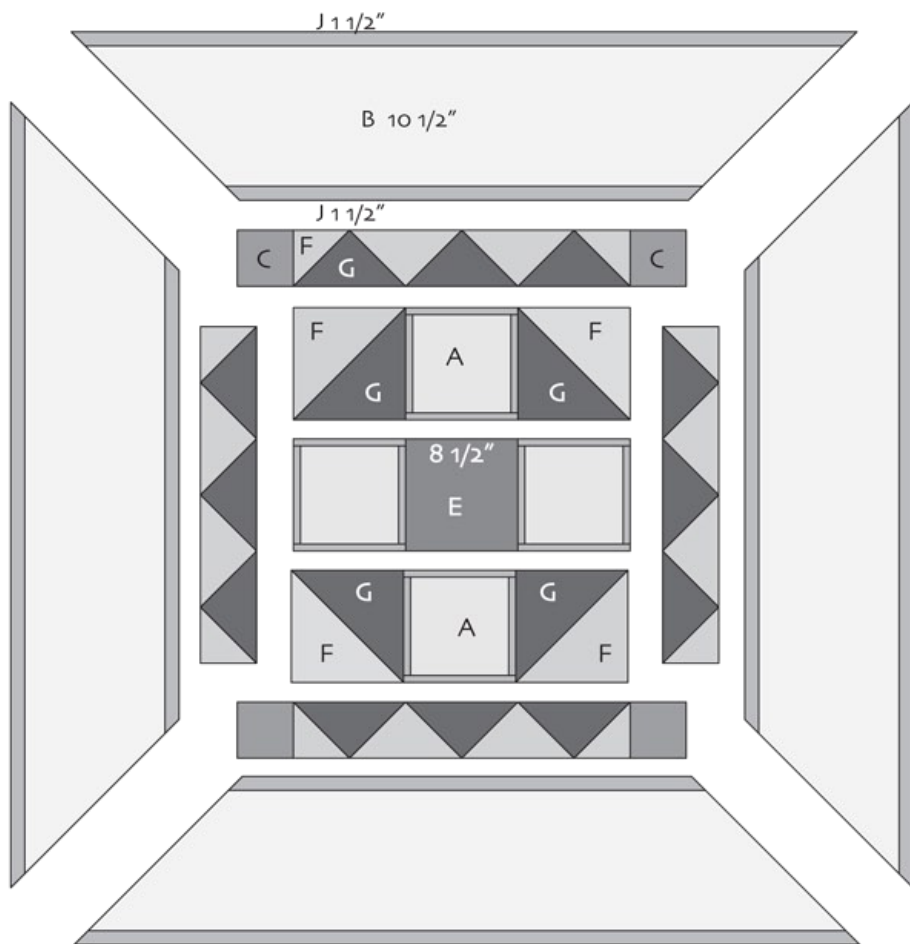


- Create one border (to be mitered) for each side of the quilt by sewing **J** to both sides of each **B** border stripe. First, sew two **J** 1 1/2" strips end to end for each 4 outer borders. Sew **J** outer borders to each **B** 10 1/2" border stripe. Pay attention and sew to the correct side of **B** according to the cover picture. (Only sew approximately 60" since the remaining border stripe will be used for Side 2.) Next, begin approximately 8" from the end of strip **B** and sew **J** 1 1/2" to the opposite side of **B** for the **Inner Border** according to the diagram.



5. Sew **Side 1** center by rows of blocks according to the diagram. Next, sew **G/F** pieced border to the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Then, sew **J/B/J** borders to the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Last, sew mitered angles.

**SIDE 1** measures approximately 56 1/2" x 56 1/2" unfinished.



## SIDE 2 Instructions

### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - \*\*cut 4 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - use remaining 10 1/2" borders from SIDE 1

**Fabric C** - cut 1 - 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" square

**Fabric D** - cut 4 - 7" x 37 1/2" borders

**Fabric H** - cut 4 - 2" strips (borders to be mitered with B)  
cut 4 - 2" x 37 1/2" borders

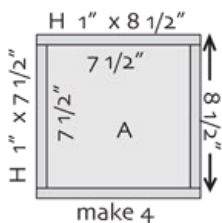
\*\*cut 4 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 7 1/2" and 8 - 1" x 8 1/2"

**Fabric I** - Inner Border - cut 2 - 2" strips, cut in half for 4 - 2" x approximately 20"

Outer border - cut 8 - 2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 2 - 2" x 53 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 2" x 56 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

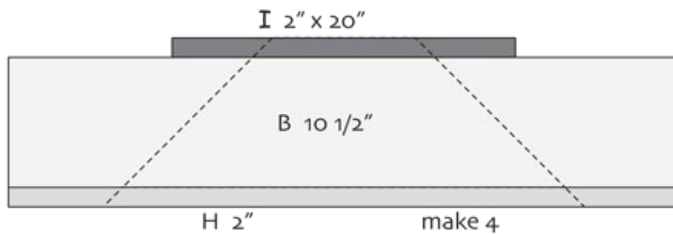
### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **H** 1" borders around 4 **A** 7 1/2" squares, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. \*\***(If A** measurements are slightly different, cut **H** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** blocks, then trim all **A** blocks to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2")

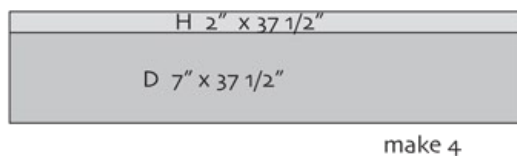


2. Create one border for each side of the quilt by sewing **I** and **H** strips to both sides of each **B** border strips. Fold all stripes in half and match middle marks when sewing together. Sew border set to each side of **C** 11 1/2" center square, opposite **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram on the next page.

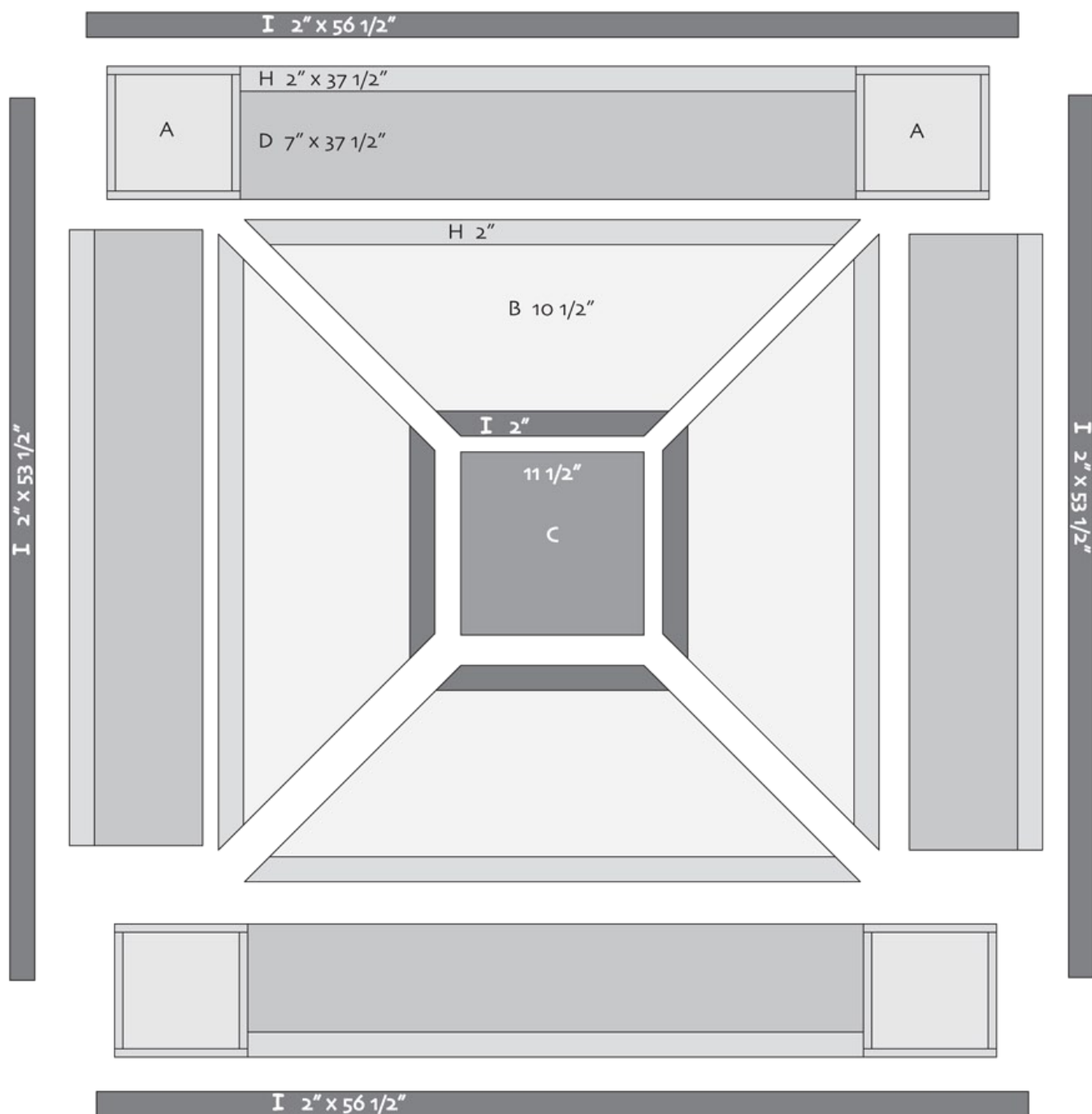
Last, sew mitered angles.



3. Sew **H** 2" x 37 1/2" borders to one side of 4 **D** 7" x 37 1/2" borders. Sew borders to the **SIDES** of the quilt center. Next, sew **A** blocks to both ends of two borders then sew borders to the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** of the quilt according to the diagram on the next page.



4. Last, sew **I** 2" borders around the quilt center, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.



5. Both **SIDE 1** and **SIDE 2** measure approximately 56 1/2" x 56 1/2". Layer **SIDE 2** (right side down), optional light batting and **SIDE 1** (right side up). Baste layers together then quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
